read the words.

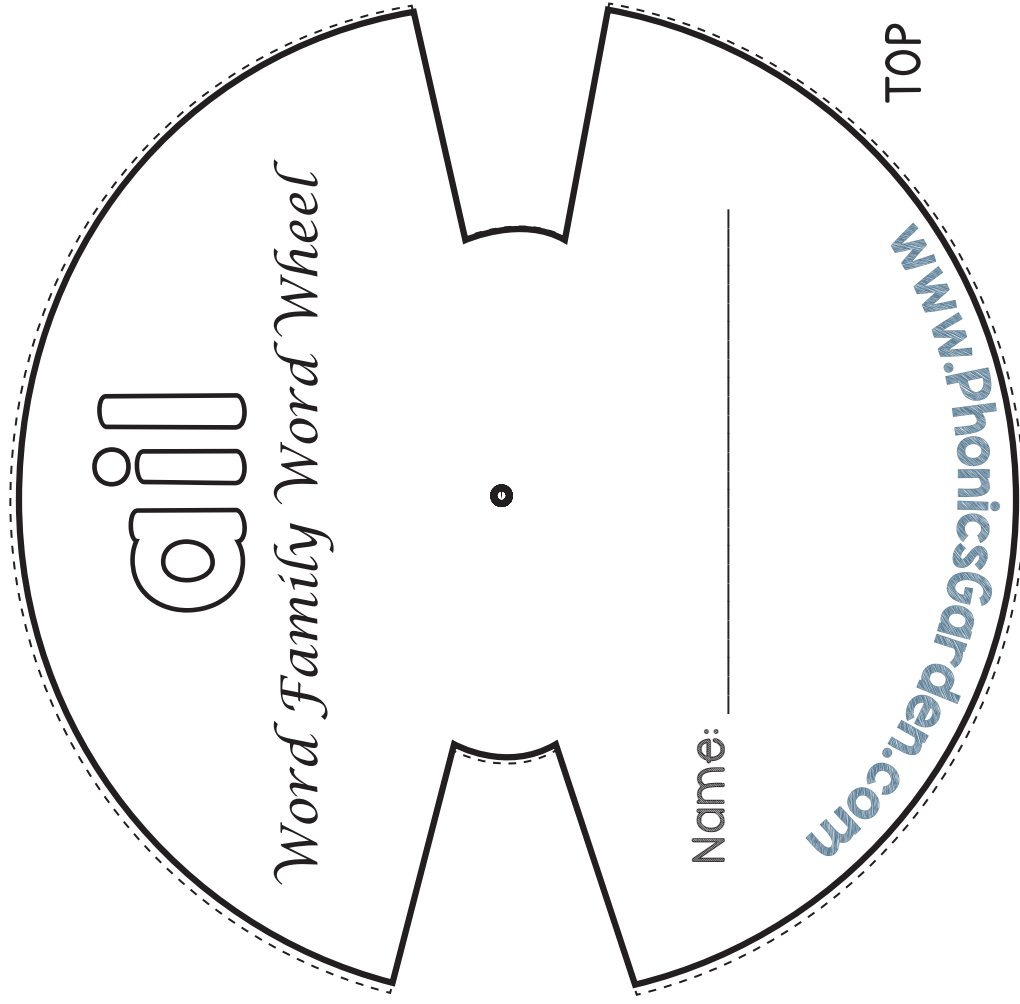


Word Wheel
