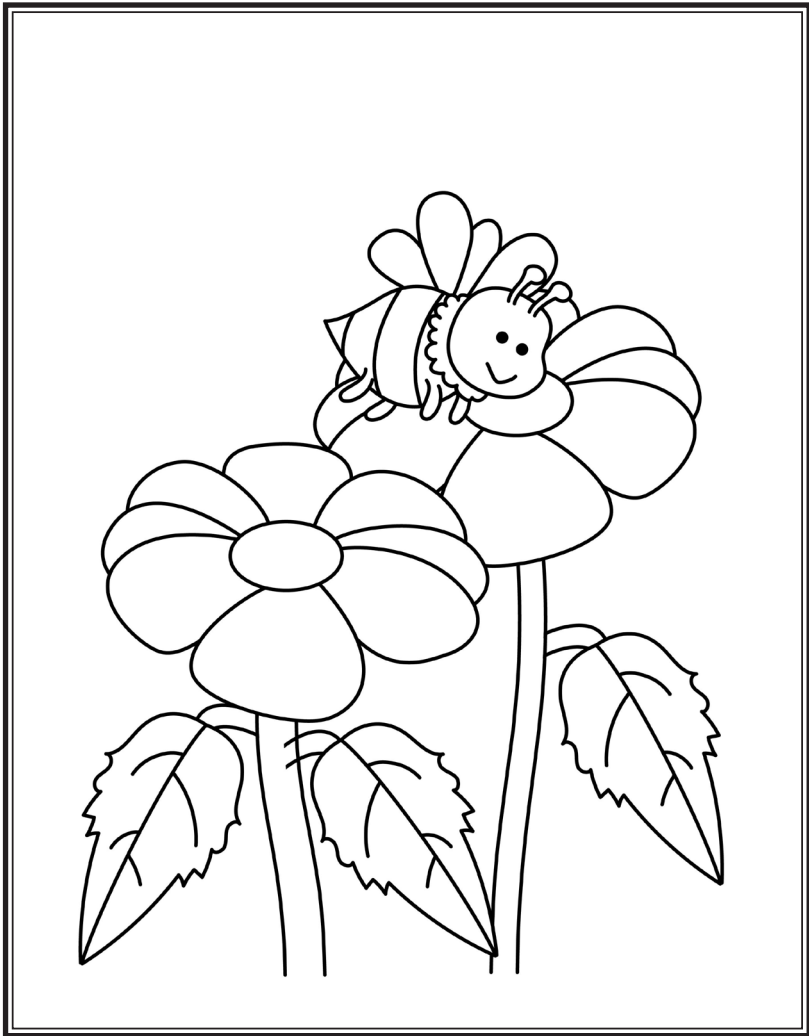


The honey bee can fly.

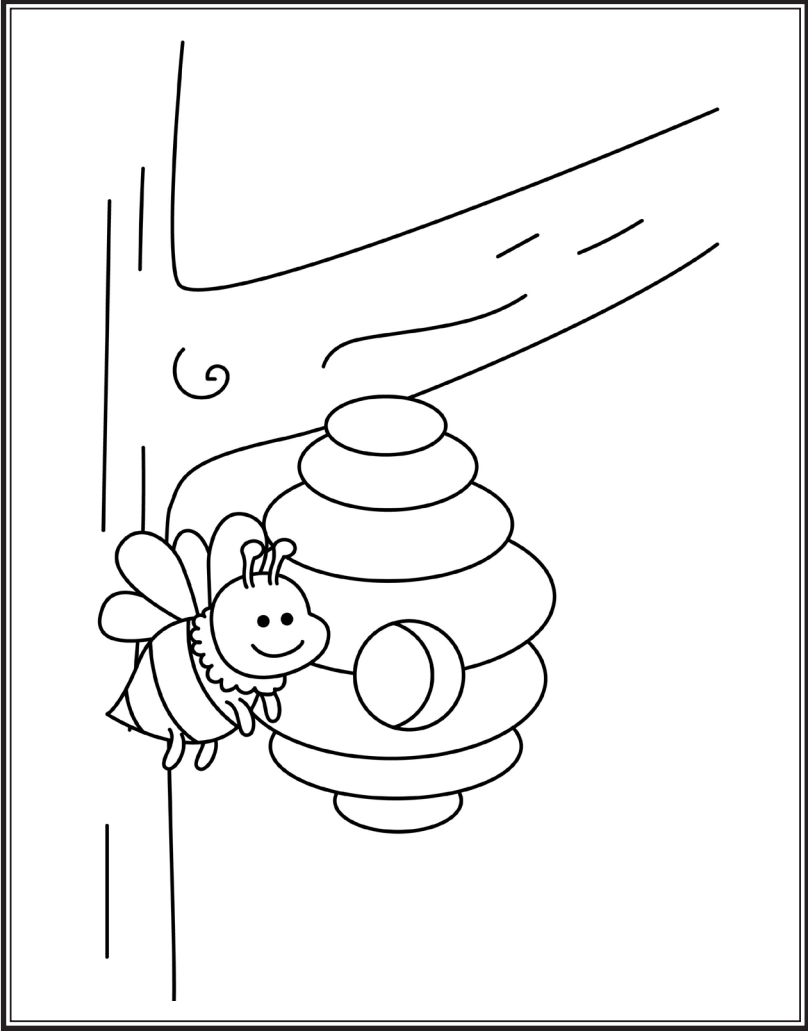
